  2. There are multiple layers of the language arts program and LindamoodBell services. The explanations become cumbersome.
- LindamoodBell program at ACA II offers small group instruction.
  1. Does the intervention cause a crutch for students?
  2. RtI (Response to Intervention) is a safe environment
  3. Discussed frequently that mistakes are welcome.
- A second RtI aide for 2016-17. Training will be available.
